This will acknowledge receipt of your report of the WBVP-AM 1230 KC April 26, 1965, test, which was dedicated to the National Radio Club.

Station WBVP is located in Western Pennsylvania, just north of the junction of the Ohio and Beaver Rivers.

We use a 1000 and 250 Watt RCA transmitter. Our 250 foot Blawnox self-supporting vertical radiator is about 1200 feet above sea level. It is on a clay hilltop which seems to have fairly good conductivity.
