Dear David:

This letter will verify your reception of WCHE on Tuesday morning, March 28th, 1978 from 12:31 until 12:47 AM Eastern Standard Time. Out of the reports received on any of our tests done, yours has to be the most distant.

WCHE is a sunrise to sunset station operating with 250 watts, non directional. Our transmitter, an older model RCA BC250M, is located 1.7 miles from the studio and is operated by remote control. The tower is 160 feet high. WCHE programs a middle of the road format during regular broadcast hours.

Thank you for your time in monitoring our station, and taking the time to write. The time that you mentioned hearing the tone was accurate, and during the tone, we were running a series of voice ID's about every 40-45 seconds. The rest of the time we were running rock oldies.

May we invite you to try for WCHE again in the near future. Our frequency check is done every fourth Tuesday of the month from 12:30 AM until 12:45 AM, although we usually conduct other equipment checks during this test.
