WKMC is greatly pleased to receive your report of reception of our signal on November 7, 1955 at 0530-0531 EST, and glad our strength was so good before WSPD knocked us out.

Your reception of WKMC is verified and the data checks with our program log.

WKMC started Commercial operation June 1st of this year, and has had unscheduled reports from all sections of the country east of the Rockies, with the exception of the Southeast, We have overwhelming competition in that area! Best unscheduled report so far, has been from Denver, Colorado, where a Mr. Francis Nittler intercepted us one morning in mid-September. He was using a portable receiver with built-in antenna, in the kitchen of his home.

We plan to run a DX test in December, the tentative date being the 10th. This program will start about 0200 EST. We shall be happy to have you among our audience.

WKMC is located in a valley, along a small stream. A Gates transmitter, using an 833A tube modulated by Class B 810's supplies 500 watts to a 200 foot tower. The "MC" in our identification is for "Morrison's Cove", the farming community which is the heart of our service area.
