Thank you for your reception report of our test broadcast on 11/24/73, the I.D. times you listed are correct.

I'm glad my code was understandable, because I don't know Morse Code and I didn't even have a key when I taped the I.D.s. I copied the code straight from my electronics text book and "sent" it by rapidly operating an input switch on the console.

Your note on the call letters was interesting. WPDC was chosen here by using the initial of the first name of each of the owner's daughters.

For your information, Elizabethtown is located half way between Harrisburg and Lancaster on U.S. route 230. WPDC-AM is non-directional daytime only with a pre-sunrise authorization for 6:00 local time at 293 watts. The test was run with a full 500 watts.
