Dear Mr. Thomas:

We are very much pleased to receive your reception report on Station CFRA. Your log of our transmission on August 16th, 1949 from 3.30 to 4.00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Saving Time is correct.

We appreciate receiving reports of reception conditions from distant points for, by correlating them, we are able to plot our coverage under varying conditions. Our transmitter is an RCA type, 1 K, output 1000 watts on 560 kc. The antenna system is a two-tower directive array with the main lobe of the night pattern beamed in a north-easterly direction. The day pattern is almost non-directional. The towers are 278 feet high and are spaced 1,758 feet apart.

We are now also operating CFRA-FM, 250 watts on 93.8 megacycles. If by any freak reception condition you are able to receive us on this frequency we should greatly appreciate hearing from you.

Thanks again for your report, and the next time you are travelling through Ottawa, why don't you drop up and see us?
