I wish to thank you very much for your letter and the data included. I was pleasingly surprised to know that our signal was heard that far away. Of course you must have had a very good receiver.

Our transmitter is a Northern Electric 250 watts. It is the same transmitter that we had when we started operating on 1200 kcs, Feb. 12th, 1946. The only change was the crystal. We operate now on 1450 kcs since Jan. 1947.

After checking our log sheet, it is a great pleasure for me to acknowledge your report as true. As we do not have any verification card, I hope this letter will fill the bill.

Your report is the first mobile report we ever had so far.
