
We are on the air since July 22nd, 1953 and our broadcast is 100% in french. I am sending you a coverage card of our station and also a map showing you where St-Georges is located.

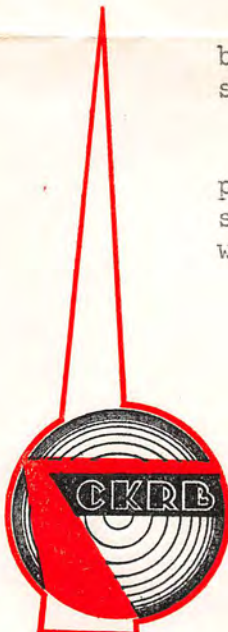
