

Dear Sir:

With respect to your inquiry, we have two low power A.M. transmitters on 860 Khz within the two hundred mile radius of Hecla Island. CKSB-1 is located at Ste. Rose du Lac and CKSB-2 is located at St. Lazare. Both transmitters are repeaters of CKSB, St. Boniface, which broadcasts in the French language. If the broadcast was in English, you were possibly hearing CHAK, Inuvik, in the North West Territories. It broadcasts with a power of 1 Kw.

Your African visit brochure is in the hands of an interested engineer in our department.
