I had planned this test with the National Radio Club, to give the members a chance to log the station. I will be running another test for them on FEB. 28, from WPEP (1570 KHZ), hope you can hear it.

Although not a member of the club, I know something about the hobby, being a Amateur Radio operator. This letter confirms your reception of the station on Feb. 19, 1976. The equipment used was a Raytheon RA-1000 transmitter with a power output of 500 watts, feeding a series excited tower(112ft) located in a salt water basin in Narragansett Bay. The test was pre-recorded on equipment to obtain as much compression as possible. Good luck, and best DX.
