Dear Sir,

Replying to your note which came to hand a few days ago I would like to inform you that we much appreciate your report which agrees with that of others received at the same time.

The experimental transmissions made by us together with three other Stations in the Argentine, were carried out at the request of the Department of Commerce of the United States.

I believe that the United States is interested in considering the effect of our local Broadcasting probably as a result of the recent South American Radio Congress, during which many important radio problems were discussed and settled, to prevent the inevitable chaos that would otherwise arise in a very short time, considering the tremendous advancement of broadcasting in North and South America.

Personally I regret that our Station should have been received in the States under inferior conditions, but it appears that one of your local Stations was transmitting a DX programme on the same frequency. Had we been aware of this contingency, we would have postponed our experimental transmission until the following day or so.
