Dear Mr. Thomas.

We are very pleased to receive reception and are enclosing a verification card in reply.

The program you heard that morning was the regular opening, with station identification, followed by the morning news summary which opens with march music.

For your information, our transmitter is a 50 KW. R.C.A. model BTA - 50 F. - The transmitter station is situated on reclaimed marshland about 13 miles inland from Guanabara Bay.

The entire area of Rio de Janeiro and its suburbs is surrounded by mountains some of which reach the height of 2500 feet.

Our short wave channel is on 15370 kcs, with a power of 1 Kw.

Emissoras Associadas, the Company which owns and operated Radio Tupi, also owns the following stations in Rio de Janeiro:
