
Dear Sir,

We have at hand both your letters of recent date. Unfortunately time did not permit us to reply to your first before date of schedule.

Test transmissions were on the dates and times suggested in your earlier communication and identification letters used were ZFY - B.G. It would appear from your report that our signals would be quite readable except for QRM. Unfortunately our assigned frequency is 1230 Kcs. but very shortly we expect to increase power from 250 watts at about 20% efficiency HI to 500 watts at about 70% efficiency and would appreciate future reports.

Once again thank you for your keen interest and postage stamps.
