It is with pleasure that I verify your reported reception of our test program between 4:20 and 4:30 A.M., E.S.T. on March 29, 1941. We were as you reported testing for Van Nostrand Engineering Service in an attempt to have our exact frequency verified.

I also verify your reception of our "sign on" at 6:00 A.M., E.S.T. on April 5, 1941. The facts reported are consistent with our normal procedure.

The transmitter here is a modified RCA 100-E with an output of 250 watts into a vertical tower antenna which is 155 ft. high. Our operating frequency is 1490 Kcs.
