Dear Sir:

Had the pleasure of hearing your equipment test down here this morning (12/8/75) on 1090 khz. between 3:35 a.m. to 4 a.m. EST. Your reception was very good, considering three stations were on 1090 k. You had plenty of interference, but the one that gave you the most trouble was the off and on cycle tone of KAAY 50 kw. test. When it came on all-else went out, but they came on only a few times during your test. The receiver was a Hammarlund Super Pro SP-600.

Positive identifications were made 3:37 $\frac{1}{2}$; 3:47, 3:52 and your close down at approx. 4 a.m. when you gave details on equipment test even down to the ZIP code. (29646). I think Jingle Bells followed the 3:37 announcement - the it could have been the QRMing station which was behind you peaking - but think it was you.

First time I have had the pleasure of hearing WMTY and hope to hear you again sometime.

Postage is enclosed for your letter confirming this report, and any data and comments will be appreciated and welcome. Hope the test was a success and that you were well heard. How far were you heard? Seemed to get getting out very good, considering the interference.
