This letter confirms your reception of KIMM on 1150 Kc
at 1:15 AM M.S.T. 3/27/72

KIMM radio has been on the air since 1962 serving the Black Hills of South Dakota and four other states with a top-40 format. We are on the air daytime only. During the winter months we operate with a pre-sunrise authorized power of 220 watts (between 6A.M. & local sunrise). Of course, we sign off at sunset.

Our transmitting equipment consists of a Gates BC-5H main, and a Collins 300G auxillary. The transmitters feed a series-fed quarter wave vertical. The tower is 225 feet tall. Our studio equipment consists of many different brands, including some homemade equipment. Our modulation capabilities are boosted with CBS Laboratories Audimax and Volumax audio processing equipment.

Thank you very much for the signal report and best of DX'ing.
