Dear Mr. Thomas;

This will acknowledge your letter in connection with the DX programme broadcast by this station on Sunday morning last, April 10, commencing at 1:00 A.M., M.S.T. We are pleased indeed to verify your reception of this programme. From the information you gave us about our programme there can be no doubt but that you heard it.

For your information this station is strictly amateur, owned by the citizens of Moose Jaw and district and is one of the oldest amateur stations on the continent in continuous operation, having commenced in 1922. So far as we know it is the only amateur station hooked up with regular chain broadcasts. We are on the Canadian Pacific Railway Transcontinental chain and also on the Provincial Government Educational chain. In view of the large response to the series of DX programmes, which we are dedicating to the Neward News Radio Club, we propose broadcasting two additional DX programmes, one on Sunday morning May 1st between 1:00 and 2:30 A.M., M.S.T. dedicated to the World Radio Reception Club and the other on Sunday morning May 8th. between 1:00 and 2:30 A.M. dedicated to the Transcontinental DX Club.

We had hoped to write personal letters to all who were good enough to report reception but the number of communications we have received has been so great that this has become impossible. This however, will express our very sincere appreciation for your letter and your interest in our programme and we hope we may have the pleasure of hearing from you again.
