The transmitter here is a Western Electric 451-A-1 high efficiency grid modulated transmitter. The antenna is a $\frac{1}{4}$ wave vertical, series fed directly at the base. The studio equipment consists of a Raytheon control console with Western Electric mikes and Western Electric 9A transcription pickups. Transcription turntables are Presto.
