Thank you for your card of December 11, 1947. Your report compares favorably with our log.

We are using Raytheon equipment throughout with the exception of a Doolittle frequency monitor. Our transmitter is a RA-1000 and we have a 265 foot Wincharger tower fed by a six wire transmission line. We are using temporary studios which are located at our transmitter. We are only  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles from the center of town.

As you probably know we are located in the hills of east Tennessee and have very changeable weather conditions. At present it is raining but no telling how cold or hot it will be by tomorrow.
