This will confirm your Reception Report of this stations broadcast of February 24, 1958 from 2-3 AM C.S.T.


Heaviest reception of this station was from DX'ers in the New England area, who reported a very strong signal. Other areas reported fading and interference from Cuba, TIRS of Costa Rica and local stations testing. No reports have been received from areas south of the Mason Dixon line and east of the big river, or the Inter-Mountain area.

KECK is now a 1000 Watts Daytime and 500 Watts ~~Daytime~~ nighttime Directional with the Major Lobe North-West and the Minor Lobe South-East. KECK still is operating a Raytheon RA 1000.

Regular broadcasting hours of KECK are Monday thru Saturday 6 AM-12 Midnight and on Sunday 7 AM-12 Midnight. Bi-monthly frequency checks are conducted by this station on the first Monday of every other ~~Monday~~ month. The next scheduled frequency check will be made by this station, Monday, April 7, 1958 4:40-5:00 AM.
