Dear Radio Friend:

We thank you very much for your report of reception of K F P M on the morning of March 24th, between 3:00 and 3:55 AM C. S. T. We are glad to be able to verify your report.

For your information we used only fifteen watts during this test. A total of 89 reports have been received from 23 U.S. States and 2 Canadian as follows: N.J. 20, Ill. 10, N.Y. 9, Penn. 8, Ohio 7, Ontario and Mass. each 4, N.C. and Ind. each 3, Iowa, Kans, LA., Maine and Mo. each 2, and one each from Conn. Ky., Md., Mich., Minn., Nebr., N.D., R.I., Texas, W. Va. and British Columbia. The last is our most distant report for all time.

K F P M will transmit again for the Supervisor of Radio on April 19th, 4 to 5 AM.
