

Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you for your card and very fine report on the reception of our station in your city. Your report checks correctly with our station log of that date.

The Wichita Mountains Easter Pageant is an annual affair staged in a perfect natural bowl with all natural setting. It is supervised by a rather elderly preacher of Lawton, Oklahoma, and has come to be one of the largest of its kind staged. The weather in Lawton this year caused a decrease in the size of the crowd attending; however, last year the crowd attending the Easter Pageant in Lawton numbered 150,000 people. The crowds start gathering on the day before Easter, even in the morning, then at 10:00 PM on the night before the Pageant starts, music is played over the loud speakers that cover the entire grounds. The music continues until 3:00 A M Easter Morning at which time the actual Pageant begins depicting the life of Christ, of course. The last scenes of the Pageant are staged just as the sun rises over the mountain peaks. It is a very beautiful and impressive spectacle.
