Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you for your DX letter of last week, advising us that you had received Radio Station W-A-C-O October 29th, 1962, 3 to 4 A.M. On May 1st, 1962, Radio Station W-A-C-O began 24 hour daily broadcast schedule and that is why you are now receiving us at that time. The program you listened to was a taped broadcast, especially prepared for the insomniacs of Waco, which requested quiet music between 3 and 4 A.M.

Was glad to have the old DX verifications of W-A-C-O for March 15th, 1931 and December 6th, 1933. A great many things have happened at the station since then and in 1934 the station was made a 250 Watt station, on 1420 kilocycles. In 1946 W-A-C-O went to 1,000 Watts on 1460 and that is why you are now receiving us again.
