This letter is to verify your reception of WHEO, Monday Dec. 7, 1981 at 1:08AM and 1:19AM EST. According to another listener who apparently was hearing WHEO quite well, the 1kHz tone was broadcast at 1:07 and again at 1:18AM. (Possible difference in clocks I suppose) And yes, you're right, I did not provide 1 kHz tones at exact 7 minute intervals. This was the first test that I have conducted and I was not aware of the importance following a strict format. My apologies.

I have not received other reports from Florida, however I have been very pleased with the test reception in the Northeast and Midwest U.S. and Canada. Other listening points North of WHEO had good to Excellent reception with some interference that Cuban "all-nighter!"

We have been on-the-air with 5kW since Oct. 15, 1980. Our efficiency is reduced to 391 mv/m/5kW to protest WCGC in Belmont, N.C.
