If you will tune your machine very sharply on 454 $\frac{3}{10}$ you ought to get us every Sunday. That is our wave length. We have 1000 watts. We send out the sermons every Sunday from 11:00 - 12:30; 3:00 - 4:00; 7:30 - 10:00 p. m. Eastern time would be three hours in advance; daylight saving time would be four hours. Listen to us.
