Gentlemen:

Thank you for your report on our special "National Radio Club" test on November 14, 1966 from 1:30 to 2:30 AM EST. We have checked your letter and have found it to correspond with our program log. In case you are interested, here is some information on WCST. The station went on the air on September 8th. Our transmitter is a "Gates BC 250 GY, our audio equipment custom built and our tower height is 237 feet.

We have reception reports from as far as St. Louis, from a car radio in downtown Miami, another from Missouri, as far south as Kentucky and even one from Canada. The Canadian report was interesting since most all reports mentioned that we were battling against 50 KW CFRB. In some cases we were stronger than CFRB, mostly in the East Coast.

Up to 4 PM on December 14, 1966 we have received 52 reports. For your information here is a breakdown in the number of reports for each state.
