This letter is to verify your report of reception of KVRS February 16th , x 1:18 A to 1:30A MST. At the time of your last report of reception, I was not attached to staff here, and since that time, we have increased power to 1000 w and moved to 1360Kc.

We are using a 20T Transmitter Collins now. Incidentally , right at present, I have part of my counterpoise system pulled out of the ground, and it might be the reason for a little more sky wave. I have most of the wires repaired and will be getting them back in soon.

We have frequency checks on the third tuesday of each month. I would be curious to know if you pick us up after the counterpoise is back in the ground.
