
This frequency is usually dominated by WEVD, New York during the day and WEVD as well as Canadian, CHUM normally heard at night. I was very surprised to hear you so clearly, although for only a few minutes, then WEVD took over.

This signal was weak and faded out. Weather conditions here were 45 degrees and partly cloudy. I was using a GE Superadio with an internal antenna. Any information on your station, business card, bumper sticker, coverage map, schedule, etc. and your confirmation that I did receive your transmission would be appreciated.

The signal was received at Marshfield, Massachusetts, a coastal community 30 miles south of Boston, Massachusetts.
