WHCU was founded in 1923 as an experimental station for Cornell University. In later years, Cornell decided to operate the station commercially and did so until 1986 when it was sold to the current ownership, EAGLE BROADCASTING COMPANY, INCORPORATED.

Our full-time, five-thousand watt facility was moved from its downtown Ithaca location to its current location - The Broadcast Center - on Hanshaw Road near The Tompkins County Airport.
