

W-A-D-J BROADCASTS A NEWS/TALK/SPORTS FORMAT 24-HOURS A DAY, WITH LOCAL AND SYNDICATED HOSTS SUCH AS DR. JOY BROWNE AND G. GORDON LIDDY. IN ADDITION, WE CARRY NASCAR AUTO RACING, PENN STATE FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL AND THE JOHNSTOWN CHIEFS OF THE EAST COAST HOCKEY LEAGUE.

WE ALSO OWN AND OPERATE W-Y-S-N FM 101.7, LICENSED TO NEARBY CENTRAL CITY. BOTH STATIONS OPERATE OUT OF THE SAME FACILITY.

I OFTEN LISTEN TO W-B-Z FROM UP YOUR WAY. THEY BLOW K-D-K-A OFF THE DIAL AT NIGHT HERE IN SOMERSET, WHICH IS ABOUT 60 MILES SOUTHEAST OF PITTSBURGH. K-D-K-A RECENTLY PUT UP A NEW TOWER TO IMPROVE THEIR REGIONAL NIGHT COVERAGE, BUT IT DOESN'T SEEM TO BE WORKING ANY BETTER.
