Nice going ... we recently rec'd a transmission report from a gentleman in Great Britain. Next stop ... Mars!

One incidental note: At 9:35 PM "My Faith In This World" is actually called "My Place In This World" by Michael W. Smith ... 9:39PM "The Strength To Carry On" is called "Hero" by Mariah Carey ... 9:43PM "I Want To Tell You How I'm Feeling" is "Never Gonna Give You Up" by Rick Astley. Not that it really matters, huh?

WBUX is a 5000 watt daytime/972 watt night-time AM station located in Doylestown Township, PA. Doylestown is the county seat of Bucks County ... one of WM. Penn's original three counties of Pennsylvania, site of his summer home Pennsbury Manor and also the site of General Washington's Christmas night 1776 crossing of the Delaware to attack those Hessians at Trenton, NJ. We're a very community-based radio station ... I've been to every parish carnival, historical celebration, parade, grand opening and tent sale in this area doing live broadcasts.
