I believe that I heard your station today (12/31/00) at 0053 hrs. There was an ad for the "Reading Times and Eagle" followed by a public service announcement that discussed donating cars to Goodwill. The program in progress had a doctor who was taking phone in calls in this case from Carol. They discussed some eye problem and a recommendation for Vitamin C. This was followed by the station ID, news and the words "Voice of Berks County".

The signal was received in Marshfield, MA which is approximately 25 miles south of Boston, Massachusetts on the way to Cape Cod. Temperature was 30 degrees and cloudy skies with strong winds from the aftermath of the snow/rainstorm here.

The reception was good with the Canadian station (CHAM) mixing in. For some reason the predominant Worcester station (WCRN) was not heard. I have not heard your station before as the Worcester station normally prevails.
