Back to traditional "36 hours of Christmas". Male announcer.


This frequency is usually dominated by local WARA, Attleboro, MA during the day with CKEC heard at night. I have also heard WTKZ in Allentown, PA from time-to-time.

This signal was strong before it quickly faded out. I was surprised that it was you rather than WARA. Weather conditions here were unseasonably warm at 50 degrees and partly cloudy. I was using a GE Superadio with an internal antenna. Any information on your station, business card, bumper sticker, coverage map, schedule, etc. and your confirmation that I did receive your transmission would be appreciated.

The signal was received at Marshfield, Massachusetts, a coastal community 30 miles south of Boston, Massachusetts.
