The WMMB transmitter is of Collins manufacture type 300G. We operate on a frequency of 1240 Kc. with a carrier power of 250 watts. Our tower is 240 feet in height with the ground system resting on the bed of the Indian River. The WMMB broadcast day begins at 6 AM and ends at Midnight daily except Sunday which is 8 AM to 11 PM.
