Received your letter dated August 26, 1955, and will now varify your reception of this station August 25, 1955. We were operating on daytime power (1,000) watts and making transmitter adjustments. Is curious to note that yours is the second letter in that vicinity. The other one came from southern Penna.

We use a Collins 21V Transmitter with a 207' guyed antenna. Operating on 1,000 watts day and 500 watts night directional.

Of interest to you if you ever come up to beautifull Minnesota and near our station. We have in the past month erected a new building for our studios, where the xmitter is located. Fixed up in western style. Quite a novelty for a radio station this far east.
