This will verify the transmission you heard on  
June 26th.

The transmission was made by the writer following  
a tune-up of the 5Kw Western Electric 405-B2  
Transmitter. The transmission you heard was  
on our 3 tower daytime pattern. We use 5  
towers at night - the only one of its kind in  
the country. There are 5 - 350 foot Blaw-Knox  
self supporting radiators spaced 174 feet or  $\frac{1}{4}$  wave  
of ant. All are driven elements on the 3 tower  
and 5 tower patterns. All five straight in line.
