We are pleased to verify your report of reception of our Station on Monday February 6, 1950, 4:10 to 4:40 A.M. E.S.T.

Our Transmitter Log of this date states we were on the air at this time for the purpose of a regular scheduled frequency measurement from 4:10 to 4:20 A.M. E.S.T. following which we ran an audio frequency run on our transmitter and associate equipment.

We operate a composite transmitter, which I built myself, the transmitter series excites a half wave antenna 407 feet above ground. I am glad to here you received me on a portable with no out side aerial this is very interesting

We operate regular programs from 6:00 AM. to 12:00 Midnight E.S.T every week day, Sundays from 7:00 A.M. to 12:00 Midnight E.S.T.
